Conditions of Entry

All registered swimmers are eligible to enter.

Para swimmers are eligible to compete at this meet and shall compete under IPC Swimming Rules. Para swimmers must present their classification card to the Referee prior to the commencement of the meet.

Swimmers may enter a *maximum* of 4 events.

Swimmers may enter the 400 Freestyle *OR* 400 IM but not both

Age as at 8 December 2019.

Entry Fees are: Individual Entry \$ 7.50 GST inclusive.

Entries are to be completed on-line only and close midnight Sunday 1st December 2019.

There will be no refunds on entry fees except as per the scratching rules

The Geraldine Amateur Swim Club reserves the right to restrict entries to ensure the timeline is adhered to.

Submission of entries constitutes acceptance of these Meet Rules and Conditions.

Late entries will be at the Technical Director and/or Referee's discretion based on, lane space availability, late entry fee \$10.00 per event, swimmers will not be eligible for prizes or points, these will be swum as exhibition swims only.

Please check names, entries and events are correct on receipt of confirmation. Corrections will only be made to entries where errors have occurred. Final psych sheets will be posted on the website and sent out on the Wednesday prior to the meet.

This Meet will be run as an Open Tier Meet.

MEET RULES

General

- 1 The meet will be conducted under Swimming New Zealand's 'SNZ Regulations & Bylaws, FINA Rules' except where local meet rules and conditions apply.
- 2 This meet will accept unapproved results from non approved meets for entry.
- 3 Events will be swum as male/female timed finals seeded slowest to fastest.
- 4 Reseeding may be done at the discretion of the Technical Director and/or Referee.
- 5 Electronic timing (touch pads & button back-up) will be used at this meet with two timekeepers per lane.
- 6 Over the top starts will apply for individual events.
- 7 Protests shall be lodged as per SNZ Regulation 4 accompanied with the \$100.00 fee.
- 8 Entry into the pool for backstroke events shall be feet first. No swim back permitted.

9 Please exit the pool at the side. **Do not** swim over the lane ropes.

Scratchings / Withdrawals

All event scratching's received before midnight Wednesday for Saturday Sessions of a swim meet will be exempt from entry fees. Please advise **Glen Smith glenstruan@xtra.co.nz**

- 1 Swimmers will be deemed to have withdrawn if they do not report to the Clerk of Course (Marshall) at the appropriate time prior to their event and the withdrawal fee will apply
- 2 A \$20.00 fine will apply without excuse to all late or non-scratching from events.

Warm Up

- 1 As per Swimming Canterbury West Coast warm-up procedure guidelines, the warm-up procedure is to be managed and controlled by the clubs, coaches and swimmers.

Marshalling

- 1 Marshalling will be at The Allenton Swim Trust Room next to the control room.
- 2 All swimmers must marshal for their events.
- 3 Swimmers should be in the marshalling area four (4) races prior to their event for distances of 200m and under and at least two (2) races prior for 400m and above distances.

Relays – There are no relays

Officials Convenor to advise all those officiating at the meet that they are required to report to the referee at the start of warm-up please. Referees IOTS & the Chief Timekeeper need to report in plenty of time. Earlier than the start of warm-up is preferable.

As per the Swimming New Zealand Regulations there is a minimum number and standard of officials required for a meet to be classed as approved and for those times to be considered for regional or national event qualification. The 'Minimum Officials for Approved Meets' sheet must be completed for each session, signed by the Referee and sent to the region. The region must, within seven (7) days of the completion of the meet forward the meet results and officials sheet/s to SNZ.
